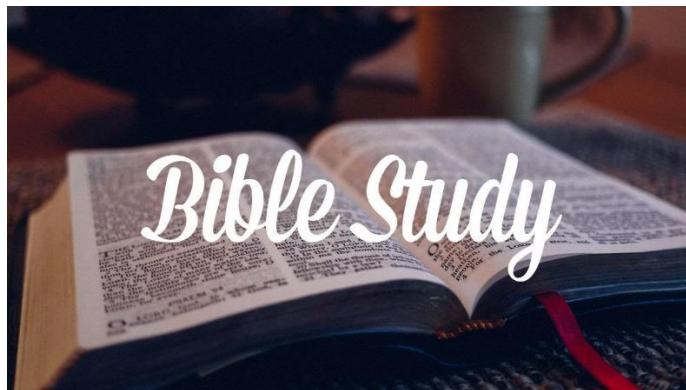
Joy:
